Ft. Lauderdale/Hollywood (KFLL)


- N26°04' W80°09'

- We provide ramp security personnel.


Badging is TSA. No waiver yet.

OPTION 1: Western U 708

Office space sufficient Parking on roof

Access to the DC-8 from the offices would be through the Tampa Cargo loading area and about 100yard walk along the building.





OPTION 2: 863 SunValley F&E

Office space sufficient Parking & hotels nearby Separate facility Easy access to DC-8

Area is old and needs to be brought to code. Electrical and HVAC need major work.

Costs and time for permits and upgrade make it unsuitable.





OPTION 3: Bldg 700


Office space sufficient Parking on the roof

- Highest per diem (\$180)

- Need to pay for 24hr security
- Runway traffic Busy airport
- Congested Traffic


